Primary Photo ID – Must be Valid and/or Current Year

Status Card
Student Identity Card from a Foreign Institute
Firearm Acquisition Certificate (FAC)
Canadian National Institute of the Blind (CNIB) Identification Card
Federal, Provincial or Municipal Identification Card
Military Family Identification Card (MFID)
Nexus Card
Student Card (Current Year)
